



Andor is a particular white cabbage from a ReinSaat breeding. The variety emerged from a population variety which has been selected and further developed over a period of many years. The objective was to breed an early maturing, fine-leaved cabbage for storage. Andor forms short stalks and bud-shaped heads. The focus of the selection was placed on the health, taste and structure of the plants. In 2014, Community plant variety rights were granted for this variety.

Andor is a cabbage for storage with an outstanding taste which forms very beautiful and densely filled heads with short stalks.

The heads can weigh up to approx. 1.5 - 2 kg and are suited for fresh consumption and for storage and processing, e.g. for making sauerkraut.
