 **New breeding**
Salad tomato Revilla



It all began with tasty tomatoes of various colours and round to flat-round shape. A systematic cultivation of characteristic individual plants, their cross-breeding and an annual selection of their offspring for several years resulted in the extraordinary character of Revilla. The objective was to develop a tomato variety which meets the high quality and yield requirements of consumers and commercial gardeners alike. Revilla is a medium early tomato with high yields. The plant owes its cultivation stability to its resistance to the tomato mosaic virus, the tomato late blight and the tomato leaf mould. The flat to round, shining chestnut red fruits have dark flamed shoulders. They are extremely pressure-resistant, have an exceptionally long shelf life and are ideally suited for professional marketing. The firmly fleshed and juicy fruits are characterized by a typical tomato aroma and a balanced acid ratio. Depending on the varying cultivation conditions the fruit weight amounts to about 100 g. Revilla forms strong indeterminate plants with long internodes and comparatively sparse foliage. On account of its loose growth, it is ideally suited for cultivation under glass and foil. The very good shelf life of the fruits as well as the shelf life after the harvest are both typical.
