New breeding Cocktail Tomato Kalinda SAAT



Kalinda is a new development of the ReinSaat breeding emerging from a targeted crossbreeding that has been refined for many years and was further developed into a stable line. This tomato variety can be described as a mixture of a cocktail tomato and a mini San Marzano. It has an oblong oval form and an attractive deep red co-lour. The thick-fleshed fruits convince with their intense taste which is typical of tomatoes. With a weight of about 35-45g, the fruits have an ideal size to be marketed as a snack tomato and as a prominently aromatic salad tomato. The fruits are burst resistant, and the shelf life on the plant as well as following the harvest are very good. The plants are of indeterminate growth and very productive. They form long, parallel grapes that can be harvested easily without their calyx. The variety is recommended for professional greenhouse cultivation in particular.
